#1 Screen at home before going to school

Have you experienced any of the following?

- Fever (100.4 or higher) or chills
- Cough, sore throat, or congestion
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

Yes to anything? Stay home and call your doctor.

To return to school after having a fever or symptoms, students must provide a signed doctor's note stating they are safe to return, or a negative COVID-19 test.



#2 If your child gets sick at school

Any symptoms exhibited by students during the school day that are consistent with COVID-19 will be treated as a potentially serious medical condition.

Sick students will be accompanied by a staff member to Trinity's designated isolation room, and parents will be called to pick up their children immediately. Parents must report test results to school and call the office the day before returning to school.
