Attendance: During our trips we practice what we've learned in the classroom, and many new skills are introduced. There is no substitute for hands-on experience; therefore, Outdoor Education students are expected to attend all field trips. Failure to do so may result in a written project assignment. Please let your instructor know as soon as possible if attendance is not possible for any trip.

Behavior: Any student who becomes a discipline problem on a trip, fails to follow instructions, or exhibits behavior harmful to the student or others may be sent home and prohibited from participating in future trips. Removal from the Outdoor Education program or other disciplinary measures may be issued.

Grades: Outdoor Education students must have a C- or better in every subject in order to go on the Shenandoah River canoe trip, since 2 ½ days of class time will be missed and make-up work is required.
