While this school year might not be looking exactly like we were hoping it would, there are many things that will look more normal this school year. For example, all of our students will be attending Chapel in our beautiful sanctuary each week. Students will be eating with their classmates in the Social Hall. They will be attending their resource classes in the resource classrooms. Per the Governor's mandate, masks will only be worn inside. Students playing outside for recess will be mask free.

Yet even with all of these things returning to our daily routine, we are well aware of the challenges that COVID-19 continues to present and will continue to do everything we can to maintain a safe and healthy school environment. Like last year, we ask you to conduct a daily health screening of your TLS student(s) and keep them home if they are exhibiting any symptoms. We will conduct this same health screening on all students before they board our school buses or at morning drop off. We had a highly successful school year last year and we expect to do the same this year. We can do this....TOGETHER!

We have some changes to note in our **resource schedule** this year. Lower school students will have additional time with Mrs. Kerr in Art and Mrs. Madler in Music. In lieu of a world language offering, we are reintroducing our science resource class for Kindergarten through Grade 5

students. This class is intended to expand and enrich the science curriculum being taught in the classrooms. Additionally, this is a year of transition with our technology platforms. Given that, coupled with the retirement of Mrs. Bransford, our former technology teacher, we are exploring the options of adding a coding class to our resource schedule in subsequent school years.

This year TAG Days will be on Mondays. The first Monday of the month will be free for all students. For the remaining Mondays each month, students in TAG day clothing will be charged \$2 that will be donated to charities chosen by our students. **For TAG Days**-- school appropriate t-shirts , shorts and jeans are permitted and shirts may be left untucked. **For Friday School Spirit Days**-- students may wear TLS Spirit wear. Shirts should be tucked in and jeans are not permitted
