Dress Code

The purpose of the Trinity Lutheran School dress code is to promote a sense of community among our students as well as a sense of pride in oneself and in our school. These guidelines are uniform for Kindergarten through Grade 8. Items listed in the dress code may be purchased through a number of different retailers, including Lands' End, the TLS school store in the main office, or the TLS PTO online store: <u>https://printingwright.com/trinity.html</u>. If you choose to purchase from Lands' End, please use the school code 9000-5809-0.

Item	Description of Acceptable Styles
Shirts, Sweaters and Pullovers	Polo style or collared shirts (solid colors only), long or short sleeved, turtlenecks
	Logos (other than TLS) may not be larger than a quarter
	Shirts should be tucked in at all times with no midriff showing. This is best assessed by raising your arms.
	Plain, non-hooded sweatshirts and sweaters in solid navy, hunter green, gray, black, or white may be worn with a collared shirt or turtleneck underneath.
	Only non-hooded sweatshirts, fleeces, and pull-overs with a Trinity Lutheran School logo are permitted.
	Hooded sweatshirts with a Trinity Lutheran School logo are only permitted on TAG Days/TLS Spirit Days. Hooded sweatshirts (non-TLS) are only permitted on TAG Days.
Pants	Tailored pants that are the appropriate size (not overly baggy or tight). Pants should not hang below the hips.
	Khaki, navy, gray, or black.
	Jeans or jean-style pants of any color are not allowed, except on authorized TAG days.
Skirts, Jumpers, Shorts, & Skorts	Shorts should be appropriate size (not overly baggy or tight) and no shorter than 2 inches above or longer than 2 inches below the knee.
	Skorts, skirts, and jumpers may not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee or longer than mid-calf. Spandex or athletic shorts are recommended under skirts, jumpers, and dresses.
	No cargo style shorts.
Shoes	Shoes should fit securely on the foot (no backless shoes, Crocs or similar).
	Shoestrings should be tied securely. Style and color of tennis shoes are not restricted.
	Dress shoes (heels no higher than one inch) may be worn.
	Appropriate athletic shoes should be worn for PE and outdoor play.

Socks, Tights & Leggings	Tights or leggings should be white, hunter green, navy or black. They may be worn under skirts, dresses, and jumpers that meet the length requirement of uniform skirts and shorts. Socks should be worn with shoes. Socks can be solid colored or patterned. Patterned socks must
	display school appropriate text and/or graphics.
Belts	Belts should be worn with any garment that has belt loops.
	Buckles should be appropriate for the width of the belt and should not have logos, pictures or symbols.
Outerwear	No coats of any kind should be worn inside the classroom.
	Hats may be worn outside but should not be worn inside the building.
Hair and General Appearance	Boys' hair should be above the shirt collar and no longer than mid-ear.
	Bangs should be pulled back or short enough so they are above eye level to facilitate learning.
	Hair should be colored and styled to appear natural.
	Visible tattoo-like jewelry, stickers, or body graphics are not permitted.
	No body piercings other than girls' ears.
	Jewelry and makeup should be tasteful, age appropriate and not distracting.
Sports Team Attire for Game Days	Game day attire will be applicable to our student-athletes only, and will be communicated from each team's coach.
Spirit Day Attire	Fridays have been designated as school spirit days.
	Students may wear TLS Spirit wear tops only. Standard uniform skirts/pants/shorts are required.
	Jeans are not permitted on TLS Spirit days.
TAG Day Attire	Donate \$2 for jeans/shorts and t-shirts with school appropriate graphics. A TAG Day donation is paid through Smart Tuition. Anyone choosing not to participate in a TAG Day must follow the TLS Dress Code.
	School appropriate t-shirts, jeans or athletic wear is permitted on TAG Day. T-shirts must display school appropriate text and/or graphics. T-shirts may be worn untucked.
	Students can wear leggings but they must be worn with a t-shirt or tunic that meets the 2" above the knee length requirement of skirts and shorts.
